GRAND ALUMNI CONCERT TOUR

When: April 28 to mid-May, 2008 (see options below)

Where: B.C. and Across Canada (Bus tour) How long: 10 days to 3 weeks. There will be a 10 day option at the beginning of the tour, mostly in B.C., with these participants making their own return arrangements and paying a pro-rated reduction in tour cost.

<u>Cost</u> for full tour: Probably under \$1,000 each. Features:

Grand reunion gathering and rehearsals in Victoria, possible beginning April 25, followed by concerts in BC and across Canada, sponsored by alumni where possible. In any concert, alumni will be welcomed to join us on selected repertoire.

There will also be solo, conducting and composer opportunities for "accomplished" alumni. I see this tour as a focus on Chamber Singers through their alumni, not as a "wake" for Bruce More! Accommodation will be a mixture of billets and hotels.

PROFILE: AMY DOOLITTLE

Amy was the heart and soul of Chamber Singers when she sang with us from 1978 to '81. Today, she lives in Missisauga with sculptor husband Don and 15 year old daughter Carolyn. Sadly, she has been diagnosed with ALS or Lou Gherig's disease, a serious neuromuscular condition. As those of you who know her can imagine, this hasn't stopped her, as she continues to work as Education Advisor at the Merriam School of Music, the largest independent music school in the

country. On August 26th, she launched a wonderful and inspiring CD of songs, flute and guitar selections (see Compact Disc list below). In her philosophical way, Amy tells us, "So we carry on as one must, knowing life is both joy and sorrow, sharing of laughter and tears of grief. All has meaning and life continues to weave the threads
