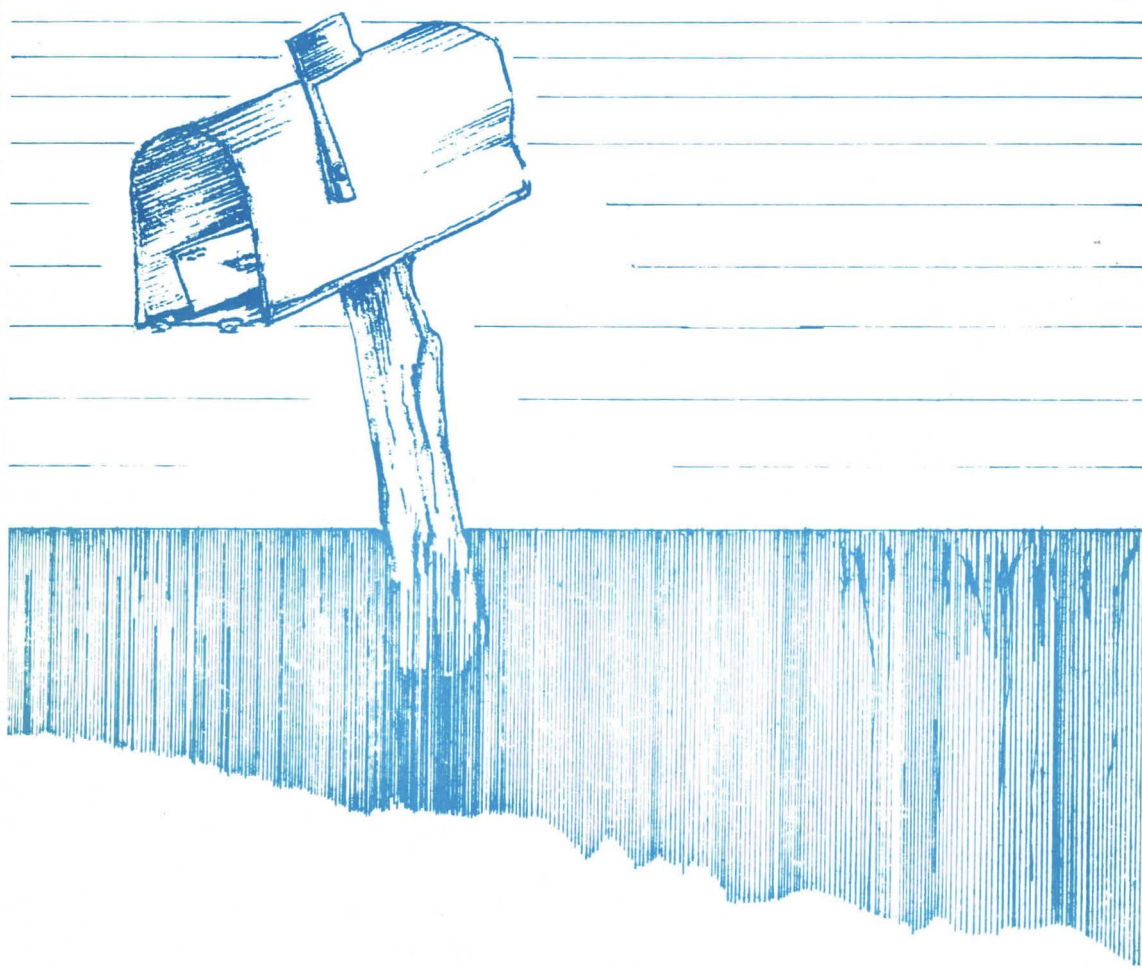

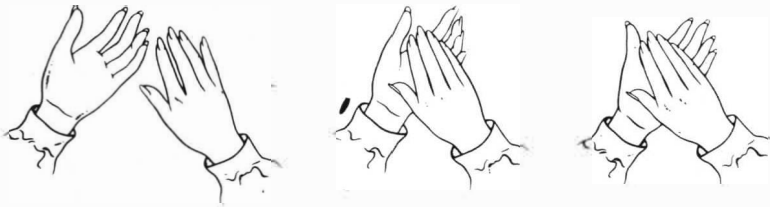

Welcome to the Phoenix Building, one of the finest educational theatre complexes in Canada. We want you, our audience, to feel specially welcome here, because you are essential to our work - education. Only by performing for a responsive, discriminating audience can students gain a real understanding of the art of the theatre.

The Phoenix is our classroom and laboratory. The actors, directors, designers, backstage, and front of house staff you see (and many you don't) are students and their instructors. Our productions are part of each student's program of study, and are supervised by Faculty and Staff.

The Department is not an academy for the training of professionals. Only two or three postgraduate directors and designers receive a professional qualification each year - the M.F.A.

The great majority are undergraduates in a liberal arts program where applied theatre studies are supplemented by courses in theory, theatre history and electives in other disciplines. While many graduates become professional actors, others will be teachers, designers, scholars, technicians and arts administrators.

The Phoenix Theatre is not a professional theatre. Its productions serve the academic requirements of B.F.A. and M.F.A. programs of the Department. What you will see will be the performers and technicians of tomorrow. Enjoy the performance!

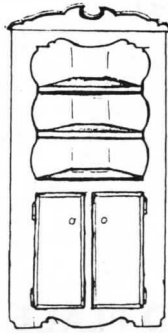

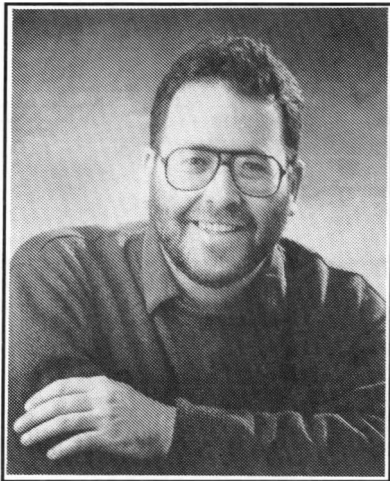

KIM McCAW
Director

Currently working as a freelance theatre director, dramaturge and writer/broadcaster, Kim McCaw has been working all over Canada since he graduated from the National Theatre School in 1974. In addition to his freelance activities he is currently Program Director for the Banff Centre for the Arts Playwright's Colony, a position he has held since 1990. From 1983-91, Kim was Artistic Director of the Prairie Theatre Exchange, where he helped the development and production of new Prairie plays. During his tenure, he directed numerous PTE productions, including *THE FIGHTING DAYS*, *THE OCCUPATION OF HEATHER ROSE*, *MY MEMORIES OF YOU*, and *SISTERS* (all by Wendy Lill), *THE SHUNNING* by Manitoba poet Patrick Friesen; political cabarets *SECTION 23*, and *WELCOME TO HARD TIMES*. He created the first stage adaptations of the stories of Robert Munsch which have become standard Family planning programming for theatres across the country. Other notable PTE achievements include the national tour of *A PRAIRIE BOY'S WINTER* and the construction of PTE's new \$3.8 million Portage Place home.

1993 was a busy year beginning with working as associate director of a French Language production of Michel Tremblay's *LES BELLES SOEURS*; a week-long series of play development workshops in Whitehorse; directing Shaw's *PYGMALION* at Regina's Globe Theatre; directing a series of lunch-hour play readings in Winnipeg called *SHORT SHOTS*; organizing a full summer of theatre writing and visual art workshops at the St. Norbert Arts and Cultural Centre; and directing an independent production of Normand Charettes' play *THE QUEENS*. Work continues this fall; this production of *THE MAIL ORDER BRIDE* at UVic; then writing, producing and hosting a radio variety show for CBC; and working as an Associate Radio Drama Producer for CBC, developing and producing new material from the Manitoba region. In November, Kim travels to England and Scotland to spend time in consultation with companies engaged in the creation of new work, and in December he begins rehearsals for Nicholas Wright's *MRS. KLEIN* in production at the Manitoba Theatre Centre's Warehouse Theatre.

Then he hopes to have a bit of a rest...

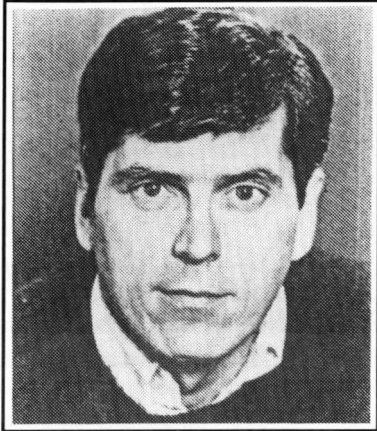

Playwright

Born in Regina, Saskatchewan, in 1952, Robert Clinton has lived most of his life in the Canadian West and currently resides in Edmonton, Alberta. A graduate of the National Theatre School of Canada, he has performed in over fifty productions as a member of Canadian Actor's Equity and ACTRA. A six time winner of first prize in the Alberta Playwrighting Competition, he began playwrighting by staging four of his works at Edmonton's Fringe Festival. His other plays include MIRAGE, MAN IN THE JUNGLE, ON YOUR MARKS...!, GETTIN' THE NERVE, and EDITING SUITE. THE MAIL ORDER BRIDE premiered at Theatre Network in Edmonton and has been produced by the Blyth Festival (including a re-mount and a tour), and Prairie Theatre Exchange in Winnipeg.

More recently, Robert has played in the PARALLAX GARDEN with Joy Coghill for Nexus Theatre and in the made-for-television film ORDEAL IN THE ARCTIC with Richard Chamberlain. And, fulfilling a childhood dream he acted with the famed Elke Sommer in the film DESTINY'S RIDGE. When not treading the boards or acting before a camera, Robert plays guitar in a blues band and a reggae band in Edmonton.
