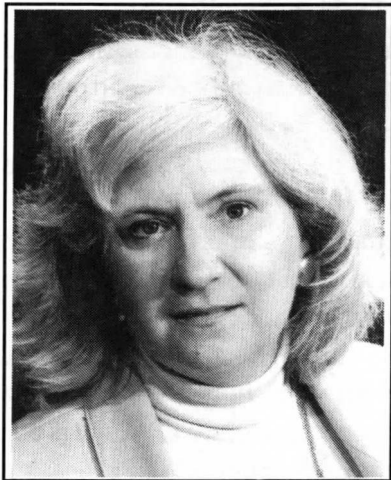

Margo Regan is currently completing her fourth year teaching Acting and Voice/Speech in the Theatre Department of UVic. She has previously taught Acting at the University of Alberta and at Concordia University in Montreal.

Margo began her acting career in the early 70's in Montreal with the Literary Theatre and in Toronto with the Tarragon Theatre. She toured the U.S. with Eli Wallach in *The Waltz of the Toreadors* and appeared in New York with such companies as Circle In the Square Playwrights' Series, New Dramatists, Riverside Shakespeare, Musical Theatreworks, Works by Women and Bogie's Mystery Theatre.

Her most recent appearances have been in Edmonton where she was seen in Joanna Glass' *Play Memory* for the Studio Theatre and in Victoria in City Theatre's production of *Lizzie Borden Took An Axe... Or Did She?* Margo received her acting training in New York at the American Academy of Dramatic Arts of which she is a graduate and subsequently at the American Conservatory Theatre in San Francisco. She recently received her Master of Arts Degree in Drama from the University of Alberta. Margo is delighted to direct her students in the Phoenix production of *A View From The Bridge*.

A PHOENIX PHACT: Playwright, Arthur Miller was born October 17, 1915, on East 112 Street in New York City to a middle-class Jewish family of Germanic stock. He is the second of three children, preceded by a brother Kermit, and followed by a sister, Joan. His father, Isadore, was a successful manufacturer of ladies coats. His mother, Augusta, an intelligent woman, taught public school in Manhattan.

DIRECTOR'S NOTES

I reread Arthur Miller's *A View From The Bridge* about a year ago for the first time in twenty years. I was immediately struck by the play's simultaneous simplicity and power. *View* is about family, about love, about betrayal and revenge. It is intensely private - an inquiry into the individual's relationship with self and consciously social - exploring the relationship of the same individual to neighbourhood, community, society and the world. Miller has likened the play to a Greek tragedy in both temper and scope. He employs the role of the lawyer, Alfieri, as a choregus or commentator on the action. Eddie Carbone is the product of a specific culture, a religion and society. For many audience members this specific world may appear remote, even foreign. But Eddie himself is a stranger to no one. For we recognize in him our individual blindnesses which remain, despite their glaring transparency to the eye of the observer, the eternal secret from our deepest selves. It is our pleasure and privilege to perform this play for you this evening. Welcome!

A PHOENIX PHACT: A previous production of *A View From The Bridge* was performed by the Phoenix Theatre (University of Victoria Player's Club) November 16-20 and 23-27, 1965. Curtain time was 8:15 and it was directed by Robert Hedley.

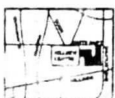

CHRONOLOGY OF ARTHUR MILLER

- 1915 Born October 17, in New York City, second son of Isadore and Augusta Miller
- 1929 Depression causes financial difficulties in father's clothing business. Family moves to Brooklyn.
- 1934 Enters the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor. Studies Journalism.
- 1936 First play, *Honors at Dawn*, produced. Wins Hopwood Awards in Drama for *No Villain* (1936) and *Honors at Dawn* (1937), and Theatre Guild Bureau of New Plays Award for *They Too Arise*.
- 1938 Receives Bachelor of Arts from University of Michigan. Begins work with the Federal Theatre Project.
- 1940 Marries Mary Grace Slattery.
- 1944 *The Man Who Had All the Luck* published and produced in New York; wins New York Drama Critics Circle Award.
- 1947 *All My Sons* produced and published in New York; wins New York Drama Critics Circle Award.
- 1949 *Death of a Salesman* published and produced in New York; wins Theatre Guild National Prize.
- 1950 Adaptation of Ibsen's *An Enemy of the People* produced.
- 1955 *A Memory of Two Mondays* and the one-act version of *A View From The Bridge* produced and published in New York.
- 1956 Divorces Mary Slattery. Appears before House Un-American Activities Committee. Marries Marilyn Monroe. Two-act version of *A View From The Bridge* produced in London, England.
- 1957 Convicted of Contempt of Congress for refusing to name suspected communists. Collected plays published.
- 1958 Conviction reversed by Supreme Court. Elected to the National Arts and Letters Institute.
- 1960 Filming of *The Misfits*. Miller was screenwriter. Separates from Marilyn Monroe during the shooting.
- 1961 *The Misfits* released. Divorces Marilyn Monroe. *The Misfits* published as a novel.
- 1962 Marries Austrian-born photographer Ingeborg Morath.
- 1964 *After the Fall* and *Incident at Vichy* produced by the Lincoln Centre Repertory Theatre.

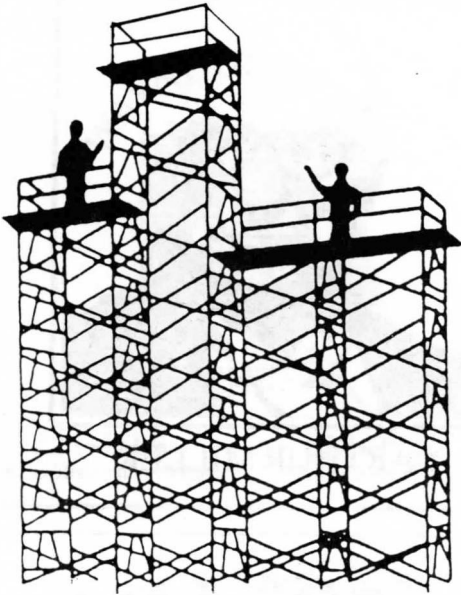


ARTHUR MILLER

- 1965 Elected International President of PEN (Poets, Essayists, and Novelists).
- 1968 *The Price* published and produced in New York. Serves as delegate to the Democratic Convention.
- 1970 *Fame* produced in New York.
- 1972 *The Creation of the World and Other Business* produced in New York. Serves as a delegate to the Democratic National Convention.
- 1974 *Up from Paradise* (musical version of *The Creation of the World*) produced in Ann Arbor, Michigan.
- 1977 *The Archbishop's Ceiling* produced at the Kennedy Centre in Washington, D.C. *In the Country*: published with Inge Morath.
- 1978 *The Theatre Essays of Arthur Miller* published.
- 1980 *The American Clock*, produced in New York. *Playing for Time* presented on television.
- 1982 Two one-acts, *Some Kind of Love Story* and *Elegy for a Lady*, open at the Long Wharf Theater in New Haven.
- 1984 Revival of *Death of a Salesman* opens on Broadway with Dustin Hoffman as Willy Loman.
- 1985 Broadcast of 1984 production of *Death of a Salesman* on television.
