Watch for five Phoenix students, Cara Dick, Sara Topham, Adam Sawatsky, David Brown and Cam Culham, in and around the Legislature Buildings, playing historical characters from early Victoria. Directing these Parliamentary Players is Bindon Kinghorn and former Faculty member Alan Hughes has written the dialogue. Rob Walker and Paul Donison are at Chemainus Theatre this summer. They both have roles in Robin Hood and The Miser. Paul plays the title role and is fight captain in Robin Hood and Nicholas Harrison is Fight Director. Janet Macdonald is in Halifax at Shakespeare On The Beach playing Beatrice in Much Ado About Nothing. At Bard On The Beach in Vancouver, Jan Wood is playing several Shakespearean roles. Heather Libby is travelling to Prince Rupert to perform in a one woman show, Postcards and Memories at the Museum of Northern British Columbia. She will also conduct walking tours of the City of Prince Rupert. Nicola Schicchi will begin his Masters in Film Directing (Production) at the University of California. Kim Pinel is conducting tours at Craigflower House. Mike Rinaldi, Medina Hahn and Lesley O'Connor will be working for Pia Wyatt at Fort Steel in the Kootenays this summer. Besides directing Nunsense for Phoenix Summer Theatre, Leslie D. Bland is directing Morgan Collins in Charley's Aunt for Edmonton's Stage Polaris and will direct a production of Oleanna featuring Harvey M. Miller. This will tour the Saskatoon, Edmonton and Victoria Fringe Festivals. Giles Hogya, will design the lights for the summer production of No Exit for The Jean Cocteau Repertory Theatre in New York. Allan Stichbury will design the set and lights for a brand new play at Blyth this summer entitled Wilber County Blues. Peter Balkwill will be at the Wisconsin Shakespeare Festival taking roles in three of their productions. And at the newly refurbished theatre at St. Ann's in Victoria, Eclectic Circus' Much Ado About Nothing, will feature a large contingent of Phoenix Pholk in several capacities; Andrew McCaw, Louise Anderson, Chris Martin, Michelle Monteith, Jennifer Swan, Erin Macklem, Tim Sutherland, Erin Ormond, Paul Terry, Geoff Gustafson, Heather Shippit, Christina Ciko, Peter Brown and John Krich. Following Nunsense, Catherine Anderson, Andrew Tugwell and Connie Beel will be working at the Belfry Theatre during their summer show, A Closer Walk With Patsy Cline.

Sister Mary Schtickmeister-Director



Sister Mary Schtickmeister originally hails from Germany where she was an active member of the order of Our Lady of Perpetual Oktoberfest. There she also launched her own television program - Zing Along Mêt Schtick.


Since coming to Canada, Sister Mary Schtickmeister a.k.a. **Leslie D. Bland** Co-founded and was the former Executive Producer of Stage Polaris, Edmonton's second largest theatre and the largest family theatre in Western Canada.

Many of Leslie's past productions have won Edmonton's Sterling Awards, including Outstanding Musical *The Secret Garden* 1996 and Outstanding Theatre for Young Audiences *Anne of Green Gables* 1995. Leslie's productions of *West Side Story* and *Into the Woods* were both selected "pick of the fringe" by critics at Edmonton Fringe Festivals in 1996 and 1997.

In addition to his work with Stage Polaris, Leslie is a founding member of five theatrical organizations in Alberta and has performed professionally with a number of organizations including the National Arts Centre, The Citadel Theatre, Theatre Network and The Ottawa Children's Festival.

During the past year at the Phoenix, Leslie has directed three productions including *Glengarry Glen Ross* and *The Tempest*, assistant directed and choreographed the stage fights for *Escape From Happiness* and assistant directed and played Claudius in Hamlet.

Later this summer Leslie will be directing *Charley's Aunt* for Stage Polaris and a Fringe Festival tour of David Mamet's *Oleanna*.

### Dan Goggin - Playwright

Dan Goggin began his career as a singer in David Merrick's Broadway production of *Luther* starring Albert Finney. He then toured for five years as a member of the folk singing duo *The Saxons*. Dan wrote the music for and appeared in the off Broadway musical *Hark!* after which he began writing both music and lyrics for revues. He composed the score for the Broadway production *Legend* starring Elizabeth Ashley and F. Murray Abraham, and has written the book, music and lyrics for an original musical *A One Way Ticket To Broadway*. *Nunsense* had one of the more unusual beginnings of any play: It began as a series of greeting cards. Dan Goggin created a line of cards featuring Marilyn Farina dressed as a nun. When Farina took to making appearances in costume at card stores and the like to promote the card line, Goggin began writing material for her to use. This evolved into a 15 minute stage act called *The Nunsense Story* which included many nuns, as well as monks. It ran for nearly 40 performances at a Greenich Village club. From there, Goggin rewrote the piece as a full length musical, eliminating the monks altogether and focusing, instead, on five nuns. Nunsense ran for well over 3,300 performances when it opened on December 3, 1985 and spawned sequels, *Nunsense 2: The Second Coming* and *Sister Amnesia's Country Western Nunsense Jamboree*.

### Sister Mary Discordia - Musical Director



Sister Mary Discordia enjoys the dubious distinction of being the butchest nun in this or any order. Before taking the veil, Sister Mary Discordia, formerly known as **Robert Holliston**, (a.k.a. Our Sister of Perpetual Facial Hair) operated a brothel in Kenya for big game hunters and became a colorful and popular fixture at W.W.F. After winning first prize in the Hulk Hogan look-alike contest, Sister Mary Discordia made the first of her many vows: never to be seen publicly without the cigar Hemingway gave her in 1958.

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
