Derek Jones has enjoyed an extensive performing career throughout Australia, Europe, USA, and Asia. His performing career includes solo performances with the Melbourne Symphony, The Australian Philharmonic Orchestra, Orchestra Victoria and the Sydney Symphony Orchestra, the latter involving solo appearances in Carnegie Hall, New York. Derek has toured Europe and Asia with recital performances in London, Manchester, Dublin, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Italy and in 2016 is performing in Canada. He has also performed as soloist for ABC. Radio in live broadcasts and has recorded recitals for ABC. Classic FM. Derek released his CD Sun Down Moon Up in 2008, a collection of his own compositions and improvisations. He has also released CDs with the Australian recording label MOVE, including the 2015 release of Flute Perspectives, a collection of solo Australian contemporary works. His career includes principal flute positions with the Sydney Symphony Orchestra, Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra, the Australian Philharmonic Orchestra & Orchestra Victoria. Derek has also been invited to audition for principal flute positions in Europe. He has made guest teaching appearances at the Paris Conservatoire, the Royal College of Music, London, Geneva Conservatoire, Kunstuniversität Graz, Austria, Trento Conservatorie, Italy, the Royal Northern College of Music, Manchester the Royal Irish Academy of Music, Dublin, Boston University, the Hong Kong Academy of Performing Arts, and the Taiwan Flute School. Derek is currently the Head of Performance and Head of Woodwind at the Melbourne Conservatorium of Music, University of Melbourne, Australia.
