#### Safety Corner

In the event of NEEDLE STICK INJURY, keep the part as low to the ground as possible to promote bleeding. Immediately report to a staff member. Request the puncture site be swabbed with disinfectant. Proceed to EMER-GENCY with another volunteer or staff member as soon as possible. If possible, take the needle with you for lab testing. A filed incident report is required.
