The drop-in centre (currently located at 713 Johnson Street) is scheduled to move into the new building at 919 Pandora Avenue by late March/early April. Although it is still too early to announce an official opening date, we anticipate having all of our programs and services up and running under one roof by April 15. In addition to the soup kitchen and residents, which moved into the new building on December 12, these programs and services will include the drop-in centre, a coffee bar, a computer lab, a lending library, a games room, a clothing room and a hygiene area. A grand opening celebration will be held, so please stay tuned for more information and details in the days ahead.
